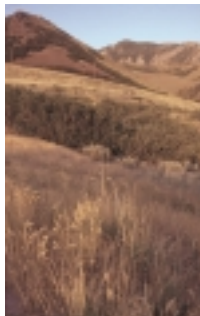

**The Grandeur Peak Open Space Preservation Fund** is a collaboration of the Trust for Public Land - Utah, Utah Open Lands and Save Our Canyons.

Together, these non-profits, with the help of the Wasatch Mountain Club, the Mount Olympus Community Council and others, are working to protect access to Grandeur Peak and other recreational and open space resources in Parley's Canyon.

City residents and visitors have long enjoyed informal access to the Bonneville Shoreline Trail, rock climbing sites, and the Grandeur Peak Wilderness at Parley's Canyon. However the sale of private property for residential development places legal public access in jeopardy.

To prevent this loss, TPL - Utah borrowed funds to purchase a 14-acre property at the base of Grandeur Peak and the foot of the Parley's Crossing pedestrian bridge over I-80 for \$500,000. TPL has raised \$230,000 to repay the loan; the remaining \$270,000 must be raised by December 31, 2004.

To help us reach our goal, Salt Lake County has pledged a last dollar matching grant if we raise \$100,000 by the end of 2004. **Your prompt donation is essential if we are to make this deadline.**

If we are successful, TPL-Utah will convey the property to Salt Lake County for use as public open space. Utah Open Lands will hold a conservation easement that protects the property in perpetuity.

This is an efficient way to preserve some of Wasatch Front's most desirable real estate as public open space. Please make your contribution today.

## Dear Neighbor and Open Space Advocate:

**Open Space** along the Wasatch Front is disappearing at an alarming rate. Imminent development has put public access to Grandeur Peak and the Bonneville Shoreline Trail in jeopardy. To protect access at the south end of Parley's Crossing, **we need your financial help today.**

### **The Good News!**

Working with the Trust for Public Land (TPL), the community has started to raise the money needed to purchase a 14-acre property at the foot of Grandeur Peak, preserving access to the Peak as well as Parley's Canyon and the Bonneville Shoreline Trail. Through TPL, \$230,000 has been raised toward the purchase price of \$500,000.

**The Challenge!** In raising the final \$270,000 needed to purchase and safeguard this property for future generations, the Grandeur Peak Open Space Preservation Fund, a joint project of TPL, Utah Open Lands and Save Our Canyons, has secured a challenge grant from Salt Lake County. If we collectively raise \$100,000, Salt Lake County has agreed to provide the balance of the funds required to purchase the land. In total, every dollar the community raises is matched almost 2-to-1.

**The Choice!** This open space is a tremendous community asset. We get one chance to protect this land. It is up to you, and every community advocate of open space, to see that this land is preserved. Once purchased, the property will be permanently protected through a conservation easement granted to Utah Open Lands.
